Saturday 10th September

We left early in the morning from our Hotel in Quito towards Yanacocha, followed by Tandayapa Pass and finally Maquipucuna. Unfortunately it was a rather hot and sunny day, nevertheless we saw some very important species, including Andean Condors soaring above Yanacocha ridge. That night we arrived to the very comfortable and cosy Maquipucuna Lodge, where the food and service were excellent as usual.

Sunday 11th September

Throughout the day, we saw fantastic birds along the Maquipucuna trails. Many of the species we saw were very important for our checklist. As a bonus, the weather was perfect to observe butterflies and many varied plants.

Monday 12th September

Another great morning was spent amongst the trails of Maquipucuna where we saw almost 90% of the Western local birds and some endemics. After a lovely leisurely lunch at Maquipucuna we packed up all our things and headed for the Cock of the Rock lek. Here we commenced a trail walk and after approx. 35 minutes from our van we arrived to an area where the Cock of the Rocks were displaying, giving us a memorable spectacle. To heighten this experience we watched the show at the perfect time of day (from 16.45), with fantastic light. On our return to the van the day was topped off with a great sighting of a Rufous-bellied Nighthawk. We then arrived to Mindo Gardens where the riverside cabins and great food awaited us.

Tuesday 13th September

After an early start in Mindo Gardens we were very lucky to observe the Sunbittern, White-tailed Hillstar and a beautiful Chestnut-mandibled Toucan. Following a pleasant breakfast at the lodge, we started the drive back to Quito through the upper Cloud Forest and Montane Forest of the Bellavista area. Unfortunately the weather this afternoon was not on our side. However, a brilliant 20 minute viewing of an Andean Coati did more than make up for a bit of mist!

Wednesday 14th September

An early start to the second part of the trip, began with a drive from Quito towards the Papallacta Pass (again the weather wasn't great). And so we decided to keep driving until we reached Guango lodge where we enjoyed our box lunch whilst watching many hummers, including the Gorgeted Woodstar, on the feeders. We spent the rest of the day birding locally around this lovely and unique lodge.

Thursday 15th September

This was a full day at San Isidro and Baeza areas (great birding areas); we saw very good representatives from the Eastern slope, but the one bird that brought the most excitement was the Black-and-Chestnut Eagle, perched right above our van. We then returned to the comforts of Guango Lodge for dinner and a well deserved rest.

Friday 16th September

Another early start birding along the Guango lodge trails meant a very successful morning with many flocks full of birds, culminating with the fabulous Red-hooded Tanager and the Slate-crowned Antpitta. After this we packed up, ate breakfast and traveled until the Papallacta Pass to try and see some of those birds that we had missed on Day 5 – which we did indeed see successfully. A pair of Rufous-bellied Seedsnipes, Ecuadorian Hillstar, the rare austral visitor White-browed Ground-Tyrant and three Andean Condors were the highlights of the morning. Despite that two passengers were unfortunately suffering from altitude sickness, we were able to make a last stop in one of the interandean valley areas (near to Quito) where we got some new birds before the drive to the airport.
